

INFORMATION ON FINANCIAL AID AND FUNDING OPTIONS

Available Scholarships and Financial Aid

At Barcelona Executive Business School (BEBS), we offer different financial aid options and scholarship opportunities to facilitate access to our academic programs and support students throughout their educational journey.

Among the main scholarships and financial aid options published on our website are:

1. Academic Merit Scholarship

Designed for students with an outstanding academic record (for example, a minimum academic performance of 90% or equivalent) who wish to enroll in a Master's or MBA program at BEBS.

Scholarships are awarded following an evaluation conducted by the Academic Committee.

2. Business & Entrepreneurship Scholarship

Aimed at candidates with entrepreneurial or professional experience who wish to strengthen their professional and managerial competencies.

A personal interview may be required as part of the evaluation process.

3. Unemployment Scholarship

Financial aid intended for unemployed individuals with Spanish nationality, with the objective of supporting further education and improving employability opportunities.

The percentage of tuition reduction is determined according to personal and professional circumstances.


4. Disability Scholarship

Specific support for students with disabilities, offering tuition fee reductions based on the applicant's personal and professional situation.

All information provided is treated confidentially.

5. Alumni Scholarship

Discount available for BEBS alumni who wish to continue their studies through additional programs within the institution.

 **Important Note:** Scholarships are managed through the admissions process and require the submission of the corresponding application and supporting documentation. Granting of scholarships is subject to academic and/or professional evaluation.

Financing Options and Payment Methods

At BEBS, we offer different payment alternatives designed to adapt to students' financial circumstances and facilitate access to our Master's and MBA programs.

Interest-Free Payment Plans

- For online programs, students may split tuition payments into up to **5 interest-free installments**.
- For on-campus programs, payments may be divided into up to **4 interest-free installments**.

These options allow students to pay tuition fees in a flexible and convenient way without additional interest costs.

Extended Payment Plans with Reduced Interest

BEBS also offers extended payment plans of up to **10 installments**, subject to a reduced interest rate below standard market conditions.

This option is designed to help students distribute the overall tuition cost into smaller and more manageable payments over time.

Payment facilities are managed through the Admissions Department and adapted according to the specific program and the student's individual circumstances, with final approval from the Finance Department.

International Payments and Payment Methods

BEBS provides students with several global payment methods, including:

Flywire

Flywire allows students to make secure payments in their local currency, often with competitive fees or no fees depending on the country of origin.

This option is especially beneficial for international students who wish to avoid additional currency conversion or international transfer costs.

Credit and Debit Card

We accept payments via:

- American Express

This allows students to make payments easily from anywhere in the world without requiring a local bank account.

Bank Transfer

Tuition fees may also be paid through international bank transfer, available for students from all regions.
